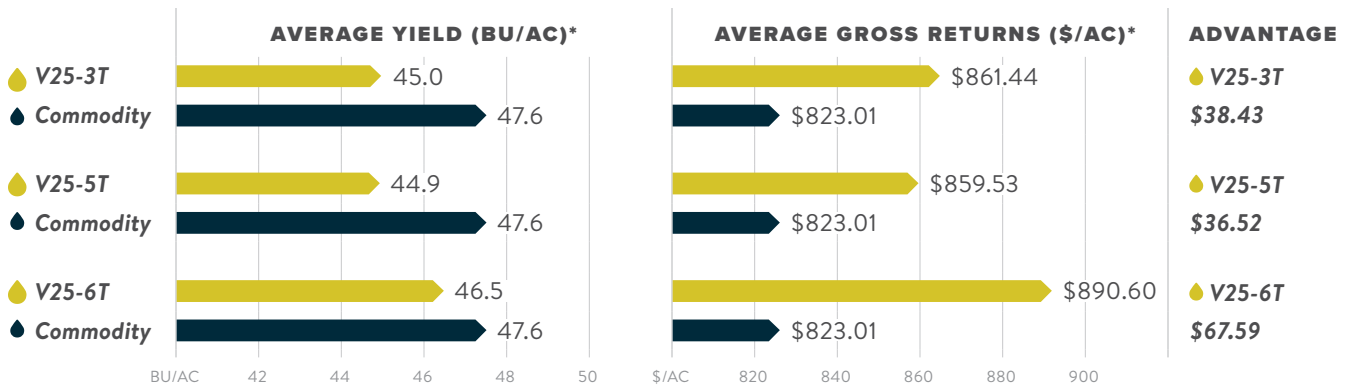

¹ VICTORY V25-3T, V25-5T and V25-6T were developed to be resistant to the predominant clubroot pathotypes identified in Western Canada: 2F, 3H, 5I, 6M, 8N. However in a commercial field environment there is potential for clubroot populations to exist or develop pathotypes of clubroot to which V25-3T, V25-5T and V25-6T (and other clubroot-resistant canola varieties with similar resistance profiles) may be susceptible.
